

< Joe McCauley Head Women's Soccer Coach

Coach McCauley will begin his third season as the head women's soccer coach at Missouri S&T in 2012, after being the head women's soccer coach for the six seasons at Eckerd College in Florida.

He brought 11 years of head coaching experience to the Lady Miner program in 2010, including a five-year stint within the GLVC at Bellarmine. Prior to taking over the program at Eckerd in 2003, McCauley served as assistant coach at Northern Illinois for five seasons, helping guide the Huskies to the Mid-American Conference championship in 1998.

A native of Louisville, Ky., McCauley coached at Bellarmine from 1991-97, taking over as the Knights' head coach in 1992. In the 1995 season, Bellarmine reached the semifinals of the GLVC Tournament as it won 10 of its 17 games, then made it back to the conference tournament a year later.

McCauley has also been active with the Olympic Development Program, working with teams in Kentucky and Illinois as the state head coach, where he was responsible for the selection and training of the state's top talent for competition at the regional level and guided the Girls Under 18 Illinois State team to the ODP national championship in 1995. He also holds a U.S. Soccer Federation "A" License.

Coach Ahearn completed his fifth season as the head coach of the Missouri S&T men's soccer team, leading the 2010 Miners to their first-ever trip to the NCAA Division II tournament and to the regional championship game in one of the best seasons in school history.

Prior to becoming the Miners' head coach, Ahearn spent two seasons at Colgate, a school located in Hamilton, N.Y., and a member of the Division I Patriot League. The Raiders finished the 2006 season with a record of 8-4-5 after going 9-7-3 in the 2005 season, making the PL Tournament in both seasons.

Before joining the staff at Colgate, Ahearn, who holds a U.S. Soccer Federation "A" license, spent three seasons as an assistant coach at DePaul University where he played his collegiate soccer, graduating in 2000.

He also worked as the equipment operations coordinator for the United States Soccer Federation and traveled with the national team to the 2002 World Cup held in South Korea and Japan.
