

Head Women's Soccer Coach

Coach McCauley will begin his fifth season as the head women's soccer coach at Missouri S&T in 2014, after being the head women's soccer coach for the six seasons at Eckerd College in Florida.

He brought 11 years of head coaching experience to the Lady Miner program in 2010, including a five-year stint within the GLVC at Bellarmine. Prior to taking over the program at Eckerd in 2003, McCauley served as assistant coach at Northern Illinois for five seasons, helping guide the Huskies to the Mid-American Conference championship in 1998.

A native of Louisville, Ky., McCauley coached at Bellarmine from 1991-97, taking over as the Knights' head coach in 1992. In the 1995 season, Bellarmine reached the semifinals of the GLVC Tournament as it won 10 of its 17 games, then made it back to the conference tournament a year later.

McCauley has also been active with the Olympic Development Program, working with teams in Kentucky and Illinois as the state head coach, where he was responsible for the selection and training of the state's top talent for competition at the regional level and guided the Girls Under 18 Illinois State team to the ODP national championship in 1995. He also holds a U.S. Soccer Federation "A" License.

Coach Hall enters his second season as the head coach of the S&T men's soccer team in 2014, after leading the Miners to an 8-8-2 overall and a 7-6-2 GLVC record, as well as earning a spot in the GLVC Tournament.

Hall was an assistant coach at the University of Dayton for two seasons, helping the team to an 11-5-2 record during the 2012 season and a top 25 ranking at the Division I level. He was also a former assistant at two schools in the Great Lakes Valley Conference. He has also served as the co-director for the Flyer Soccer Academy that served over 700 youth players annually as well as serving as the Director of Coaching for the Roseburg Soccer Association in Roseburg, Ore. where he over-

He was an assistant at New Mexico for two season, where the Lobos amassed a record of 20-11-2, including a top 25 ranking. He also spent one season as the assistant coach for the men's and women's soccer teams at the University of Indianapolis, and was the first assistant at the University of Southern Indiana for the 2006 season.

He has his United States Soccer Federation National "B" and National "Y" coaching licenses and a director of coaching diploma from the National Soccer Coaches Association of America.


